Think Like Water, and Weather

Water will always find a way in if we leave a path. So every decision, from fastener placement to flashing details, should be made with water flow in mind.

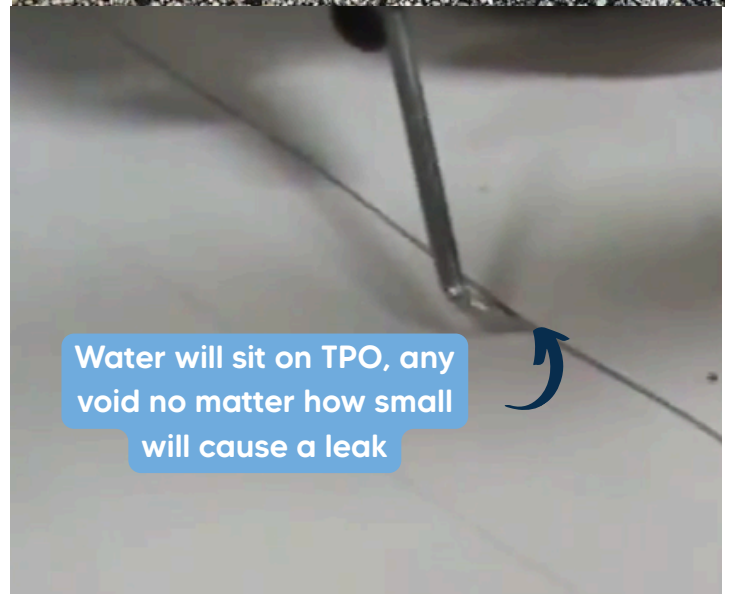
But to truly install roofs that last, we take it further: “Think like weather.”

Consider wind, sun, and rain, not just today, but for the next 20+ years.

Ask yourself:

- Will this exposed fastener leak over time?
- Could this unsealed edge catch wind and peel back?
- Will UV exposure break down this sealant too soon?

When you think long-term, you make smart, proactive roofing choices.

Build for Beauty, Not Just Strength

Once weather resistance is locked in, aesthetics come next. A roof is one of the most visible parts of a home, it needs to look as good as it performs. That means:

- Straight lines across shingles and metal
- Clean detail cuts around vents, edges, and valleys
- Tight finishes on trim and flashing
- Take your time on the details. Speed doesn't matter if it looks rushed.

Respect the Homeowner's Vision

Every homeowner has a slightly different idea of what "looks good." or "aesthetic":

- Before finishing aesthetic details (like roof paint color, flashing along a roof to wall) ask for feedback.
- Checking in during the project gives them confidence in the process, and gives us a chance to make any changes before it's too late.
- Always set expectations on aesthetic details before continuing. "Setting expectations" just means making sure the homeowner knows what it will look like and understands that and is okay with that **before** finalizing it.



To do roofing the Trust way:

- **Think like water** - What will water do over the course of 20 years? Think like that and adapt and flow around challenges.
- **Think like weather** - What will the wind and sun do over the course of 20 years?
- **Build roofs that last-and look sharp doing it** - Durability and craftsmanship go hand in hand.
